

NBC Learn is a tool that is now available for WVU faculty to use in their courses. This tool provides access to videos from NBC's archive. This gives instructors access to an extensive variety of videos covering much of the 20th century. This sheet outlines several ways you can direct your students to NBC Learn videos in your WVU eCampus class.

Where to Log In

To log in to the NBC Learn site, **always use your WVU Master ID at this address:** <http://nbclearn.wvu.edu>

Logging in at the *above address only* is free for WVU faculty and students. If you go to the main NBC Learn page, you will be asked for payment.

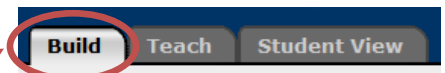
Enabling the WVU eCampus Web Links Tool

The easiest way to share NBC Learn with students in your WVU eCampus course is to create a Web Link.

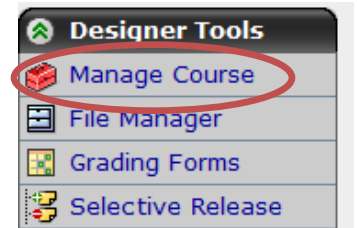
1. Check the **course menu bar** on the left side of your WVU eCampus course to see if the Web Links tool is turned on.



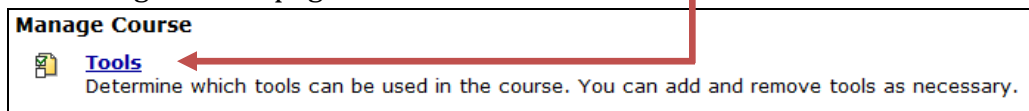
2. If you do not see the Web Links tool on the left menu bar, then you need to enable it. Make sure that you are in the **Build tab**.



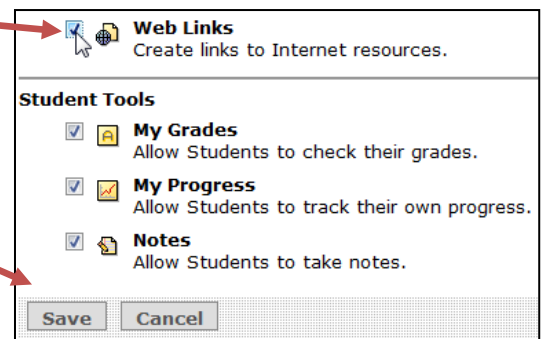
3. Click the **Manage Course button** on the course menu bar. It is in the section of buttons at the bottom, called "Designer Tools."



4. The Manage Course page should load. Click **Tools link**. It is the first item on the Manage Course page.



5. Click the Check-box next to "Web Links" in order to put a check-mark there.



6. Click the **Save button**.

7. Click the **Web Links** button on the course menu bar.



8. Click the **Create Web Link** button



9. Fill in the title, description, and Web Address as shown in the example at the right.

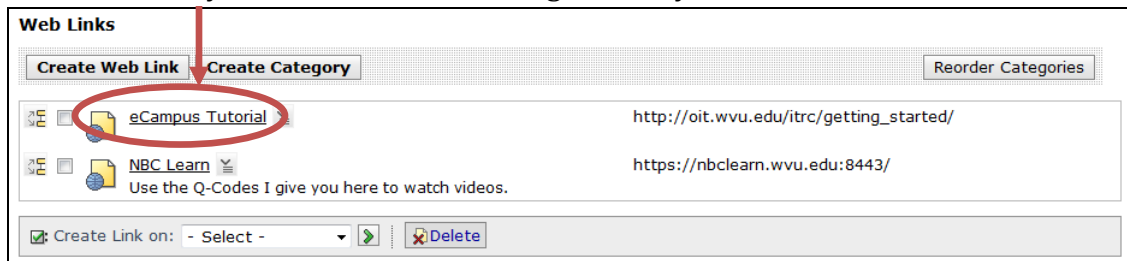

10. It is a good idea to check the box next to "Open in a new browser window".

11. Once you are finished, click the **Save Button**.

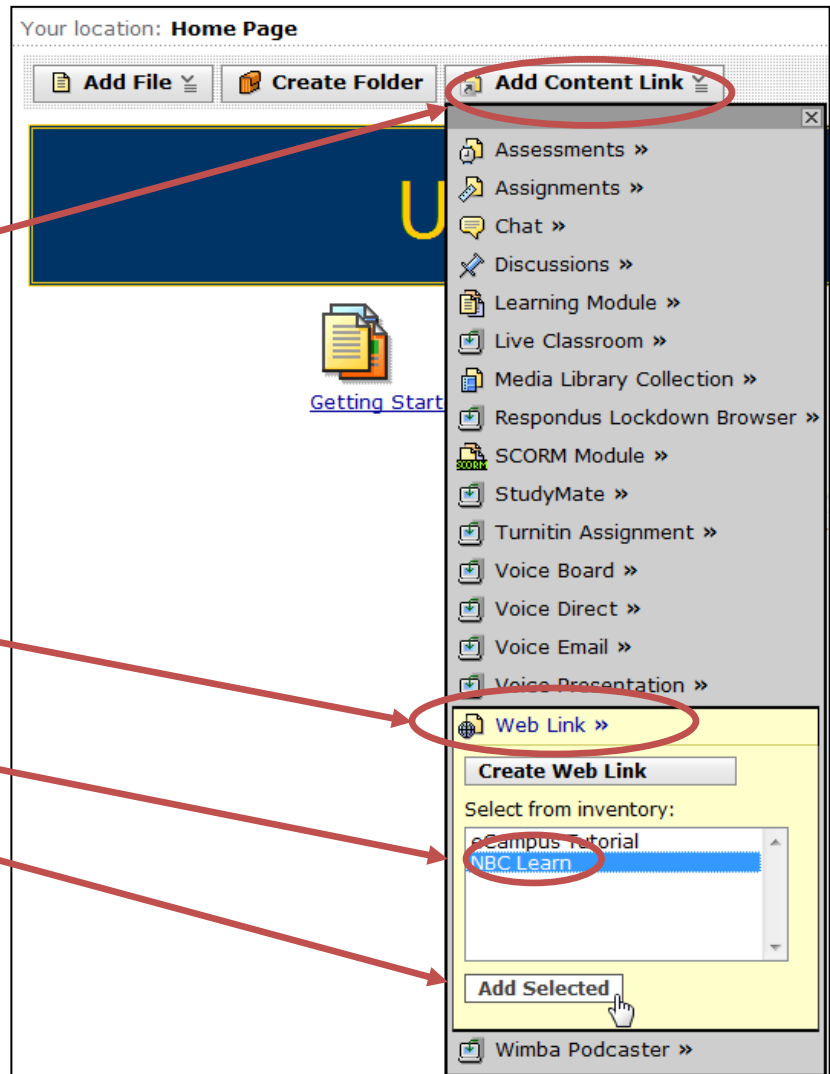
12. You will now have a Web Link that your students can use to go directly to NBC Learn.



Adding the NBC Learn Web Link to a Course Page

You can add the Web Link that you have just created to a page in your WVU eCampus course.

1. Go to the page in your WVU eCampus Course where you want to add the Web Link you just made for NBC Learn.
2. Click the **Add Content Link** button.
3. Click **Web Link** in the menu that pops up.
4. You will see any web links that you have created. Click the NBC Learn Web Link.
5. Click the **Add Selected** button
6. You will now have a Web Link on the course page, which will be easy for students to find.

Using Cue-Card Numbers

All videos in the NBC Learn archive have a Cue-Card Number that you can give students so that they can find a specific video you have chosen.

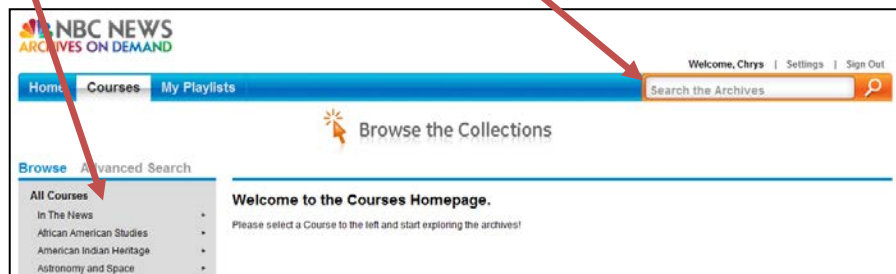
1. Go to <http://nbclearn.wvu.edu>
2. Log in with your Master ID.
3. After you log in, you will see the box on the right. Your students can paste in a Cue Card Number you have given them to watch a specific video.

If you were provided a CueCard number by your instructor, please enter it below.
If you do not have a CueCard number, click on the button to proceed.

Finding Cue-Card Numbers

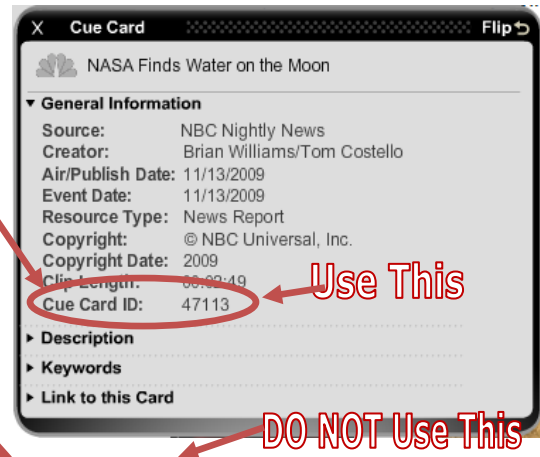
1. To find a video Cue-Card number to share with your students, click the **Go to NBCLearn button**.
2. You will see the NBC Learn Browse Page. On the left, there will be a list of categories. You can look for videos by clicking on categories, or by using the Search function at the top of the page.



3. Once you find a video you like, and click on it, the video's Cue Card will load, and the video will begin to play.
4. Click the **Flip** item in the top right corner of the Cue Card.



5. The back of the Cue Card has information about the video, including date, show, copyright, etc.
6. The **Cue Card ID** is listed at the bottom of the General Information.
7. You can copy this number and paste it into an assignment, activity, discussion message, etc. in your WVU eCampus Course to share with your students.
8. DO NOT USE the link at the bottom of the card. It will take your students to the main NBC Learn site and ask them for money.



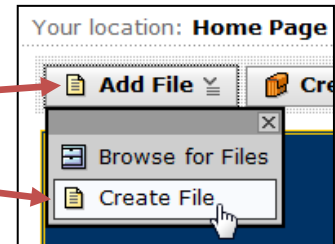
NOTE:
 It is important that always have your students the Web link that you created to log into the WVU NBC Learn page at this address: <http://nbclearn.wvu.edu>
 This is the only way to ensure that students will be covered by the WVU license, and will not be asked to pay to view videos.

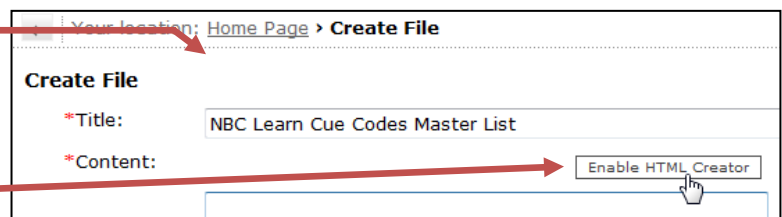
Keeping a Master List

It is a suggested best practice to provide a master list of all Cue Card Codes that you use in the course as a reference for your students. This could be provided in several ways. For example, such a list could be added as the last page of a syllabus, or added to a “Resources” list in your WVU eCampus course. Below are instructions for creating a master list page in your WVU eCampus course.

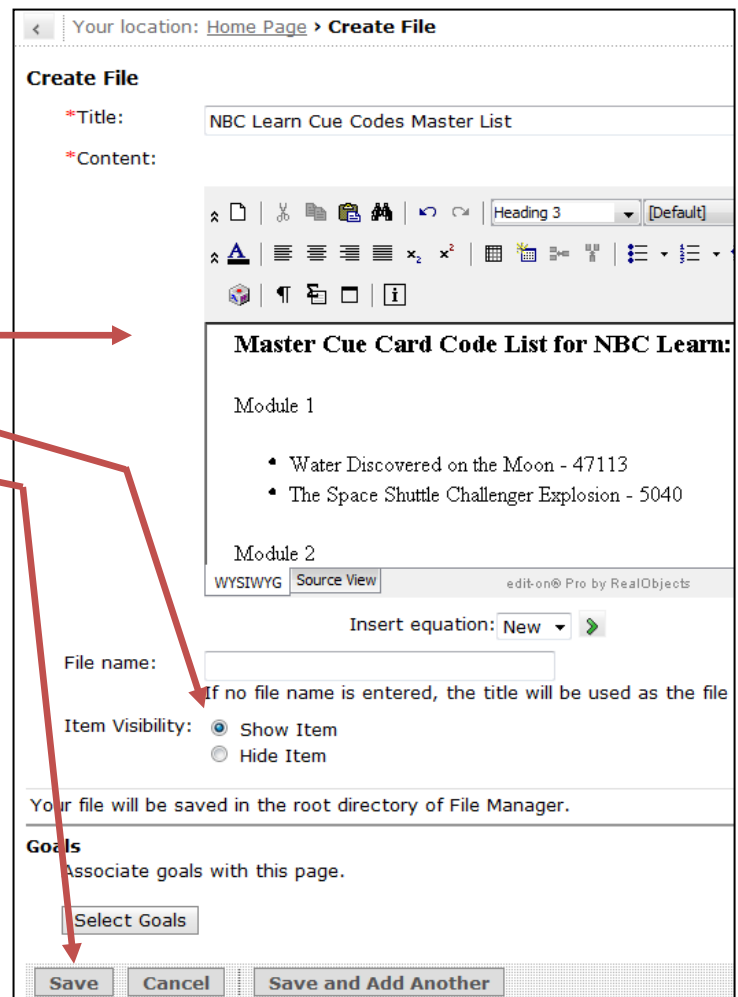
1. Go to the page in your WVU eCampus course where you would like the master list to appear.
2. Click the **Add File** button.
3. On the pop-up menu, click **Create File**.



4. Enter the title of the page in the **Title** box.
5. Click the **Enable HTML Creator** button.



6. The HTML Creator will load, allowing you to format your page.



7. Create your list in the **Content** Box.
8. Check that **Show Item** is selected.
9. Click the **Save** button.
10. You will have a new icon for the Master List on your WVU eCampus course page, like this:
